We welcome people with lived experience of disabilities or health care needs who want a chance to have their voices heard and want to help shape a society that works for everyone.

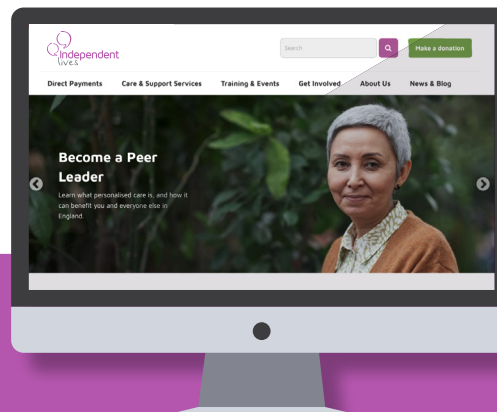
